

Setting up Secure Fast Erase on HP MFP's

This operation can be performed by going into the EWS (embedded web server) of the MFP or using WJA (web jet administration).

1. Go to the EWS of the device.
2. Go to the settings tab.
3. Go to the security option on the left hand side of the page.
4. Choose configure under Device Security Settings.
5. Create a password for the File System Password.
6. Select Secure Fast Erase in the File Erase Mode section of the page.
7. Select Apply.

The MFP will now overwrite any document once it is released from the HDD with 0 and 1 one time. This will allow for a secure HDD with no major impact on read/write performance.

The following instructions are how to save and push the secure erase template using WJA.

1. Open WJA
2. Pick the MFP that was just configured previously.
3. Choose the configuration tab and go to file system.
4. Check mark file system external access, set file system password, and set secure file erase mode.
5. Select save as a template.
6. You will need to re-enter the password for the file system password.
7. Save the template as Secure Erase

8. Go to configuration under the device management section of WJA.
9. Apply the Secure Erase template to the groups.
